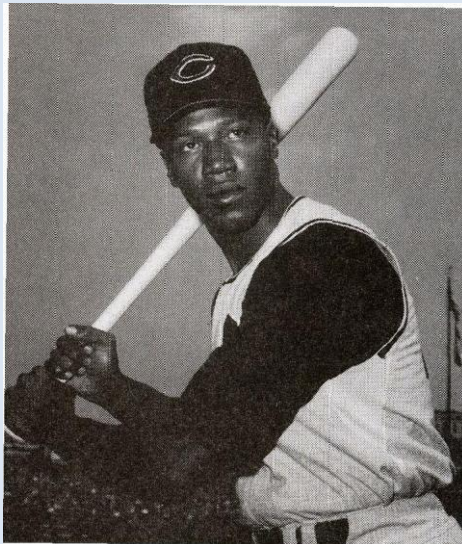

## *Chuck Hinton*

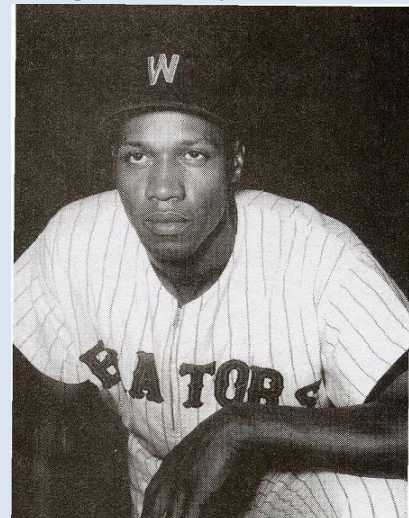


Who is the last Washington Senators player to bat over .300 in a season? Yes, indeed, it was Chuck who accomplished the feat in 1962.

Chuck began playing for the Senators in 1961 and led the team in stolen bases each of his 34 seasons in the capital. His best season came in his sophomore year, 1962, when he batted .310 (4<sup>th</sup> in the American League), hit 17 home runs, drove in 75 runs, scored 73 runs and stole 28 bases. He also had hitting streaks of 17 and 15 games that year. In 1964, he was selected to the American League All-Star team.

Chuck was traded to the Cleveland Indians for the 1965 season and played on the shores of Lake Erie for 3 seasons before spending a season with the California Angles in 1968. He then went back to the Indians in a trade for Lou Johnson and ended his 11 year career in 1971.

Chuck has authorized his autobiography titled "My Time At Bat". His number 32 is honored in the Washington Wall of Stars in right field at RFK Stadium.
