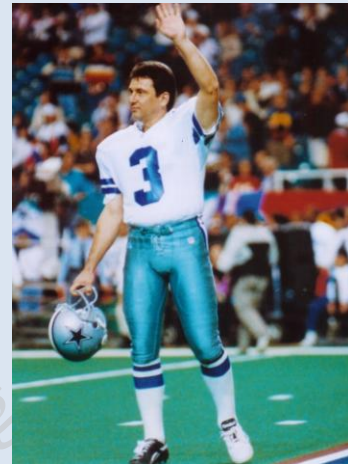




Eddie Murray

Eddie Murray is one of the top scoring players in NFL history and is currently ranked #14 all-time with 1,594 points. At the time of his retirement in 2000, that career point total ranked him #6 all-time. He was known as “Steady Eddie” and “Money Murray” through his 19 year pro football career and was astonishingly consistent in converting point-after touchdown kicks, hitting 258 straight in one stretch. His cool demeanor under pressure gave the seven National Football League teams on which he played a chance to win tight games.



In 1976, Eddie’s all-around athleticism and kicking ability earned him a scholarship to Tulane University. This Canadian citizen broke most of the school’s kicking records and was drafted by the Detroit Lions in 1980. He had an auspicious NFL beginning as he won the kicking job with the Lions and led the team with 116 points. Eddie was picked for the Pro Bowl his rookie season and was named MVP of the Pro Bowl Game after kicking four field goals.

Having played 12 seasons in Detroit, Eddie left the Lions in 1992 at the age of 35, splitting the '92 season between the Tampa Bay Buccaneers and the Kansas City Chiefs. In 1993, Eddie had a career year with the Dallas Cowboys. As a member of the Cowboys’ organization, he amassed a personal best of 122 points and set a team record with 28 field goals. In Super Bowl XXVIII, Eddie played an integral role by kicking 3 field goals as the team rolled to a 30-13 win over the Buffalo Bills. This was Eddie’s only Championship season.

Murray moved on to the Philadelphia Eagles in 1994, then over to the Washington Redskins in 1995 where he scored 114 points, his 4th highest season total at age 39. After taking the 1996 season off, he came back to play a season with the Minnesota Vikings, Cowboys in 1999 and finally retired from the NFL as a Redskin in 2000.



Eddie’s accolades include being named Kicker of the All-Decade Team of the 1980’s, First Team All-Pro (1980) and making two Pro Bowl appearances (1980 & 1989).

Today Eddie continues his love of the game of football as he coaches kickers across the country to assist them in getting athletic scholarships. Eddie Murray is the ideal candidate to run a kicking clinic or to share his great stories from the gridiron compiled over two decades in the game.
