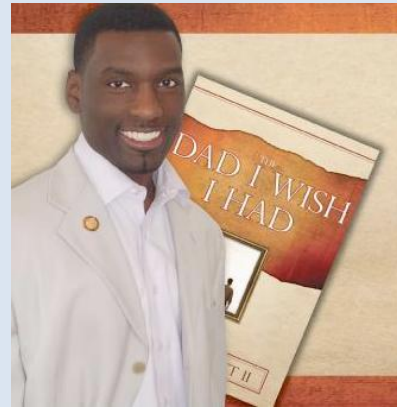




Freddie Scott

Freddie had a standout college football career as a wide receiver at Penn State where he set the school record for most catches in a game (13) and was featured on the cover of Sports Illustrated. Freddie Scott II is a second-generation player in the National Football League having played for the Atlanta Falcons and Indianapolis Colts. He father, also Freddie Scott, had a 10-year career as a wide receiver with the Baltimore Colts and Detroit Lions.



Since retiring from the game, Freddie has become a pastor, youth counselor, public speaker, and author. He is the founder and president of Unlock the Champion, LLC, an organization dedicated **empowering families** and the teaching of fundamental life skills essential to **character development** for people who are raised in **broken homes**, especially **athletes**. His most recent research has made him aware of the tremendous need, now more than ever, for strong fathers in America's ever-changing culture and across the world. This understanding inspired his first book entitled, "The Dad I Wish I Had", which features a foreword by Super Bowl winning coach, Tony Dungy.

Today Freddie travels throughout America speaking on such issues as **family, character development, and personal goals**. To date, Freddie has spoken to thousands of men and youth helping to empower them to not be imprisoned to the pain of their past. He is an NFL Spokesman for Tony Dungy's organization All Pro Dad, a recent graduate of the Pastoral Leadership Academy where he received training in conflict resolution, coaching, and team building for leaders. Freddie is a partner with the Family Research Council in Washington, D.C. and is also the Assistant Pastor at Word of Faith Christian Center in Nashville where he serves as the Dean of their ministries bible school.
